**IN THE MATTER OF an Application for an
Order granting Standing in all Formal
Hearings of the Inquiry**

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Child Youth Advocate will have standing to participate in the following parts of the Inquiry:

- i) Formal Hearings on the history of the Innu;
- ii) The Formal Hearings on the history of child protection in relation to the Innu;
- iii) The Formal Hearings on legislation, policies and practices of the child protection system in relation to the Innu;
- iv) Each Formal Hearing in relation to the six death investigations to be undertaken pursuant to s. 4(2) of the Terms of Reference;
- v) Written and oral submissions with respect to findings of fact and recommendations in relation to all parts of the Inquiry.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Nunatsiavut Government shall have the following participation rights:

- i) The right to examine witnesses with leave of the Commissioners unless the conduct of the Child Youth Advocate is at issue and in such a circumstance the Child Youth Advocate will have the right to cross examine witnesses;
- ii) The right to call the Child Youth Advocate as a witness when the conduct of the Youth Advocate is at issue;
- iii) The right to make written and/or oral Submissions;

- iv) Access to documents relevant to the Formal Hearings to which they have been granted Standing;
- v) Any other rights of participation as may be granted by the Commissions.
