Present wording of list:

Decreased numbers of First Nation children in protective care and custody

Expanded capacity of Child, Youth and Family services in First Nation communities through both internal and external partnerships
Improved community level understanding and support of CYFS roles, responsibilities and services in each First Nation
Enhanced quality of services throughout the continuum of care through the leveraging of external and internal partnerships and case conferencing

Increased local capacity for foster and kinship care (no change)

Expanded capacity of Child, Youth and Family services in First Nation communities including a range of service partners (CHANGE)
