As requested, please find below the specific ages of the children being followed by CYFS in Natuashish. The updated number is 32 and not 33 as originally communicated.

There are seven sibling groups within the 32...one group of four siblings in a family, two groups of three and four groups of two.

There are eleven children 10 years of age and under.

One of the 15 year olds and one of the 16 years olds are at the Woods Treatment Centre in Calgary and a third child considered high risk who is eleven was to be transported to the same facility today but is on weather hold. He is a sibling of the 16 year old who is already at Woods.

Spoke with Lyla in SJ (897-5570); she'll be at Pippy Place tomorrow re. Adoptions meetings. I also spoke with Lynne and Joanne in NSH. Lynne is up there this week. Their new clinical manager started today in SSS. The summary of their info is as follows:

- 14/32 on CYFS caseload prior to 'list'; no new intakes done
- 'list' formed by CYFS as part of community forum work; not compiled by FN
- CYFS sent 2 children/1 youth to Woods Homes: [REDACTED]
- [REDACTED] have the same mother. No knowledge of 4<sup>th</sup> child/youth
- [REDACTED] younger sister in care, placed in BARTS; [REDACTED] siblings have CYFS involvement
- the FN has arranged for treatment-numbers unknown to CYFS
- Lyla would need to see the list to recall sibling groups and not aware of any FCAPs re. sibling groups; Lynne and Joanne not aware of any sibling groups.
- Lyla discussed [REDACTED] family-large dispersed sibling group with members on CWA, protection and traditionally adopted
