AT-93/94-005-BF-A01THIS AMENDING BRIGHTER FUTURES CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT
made in duplicate

BETWEEN: HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN in Right of Canada ("Her Majesty"), as represented by the Minister of National Health and Welfare ("the Minister")

AND: INNU NATION HEALTH COMMISSION, a Native body incorporated under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland/Labrador, ("the Recipient").

WHEREAS Her Majesty and the Recipient wish to amend their Agreement dated 20th day of January 1994 and amended the 18th day of February 1994 ("the Agreement") to add a new one-time funding item to the budget and by increasing the budget by \$28,550.00 to cover the costs for Suicide Prevention/Intervention Coordinator.

THEREFORE, Her Majesty and the Recipient agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Agreement is deleted and the following is substituted therefor:
 - "1. The Project shall consist of the objectives and activities set out in Appendix "A-1"."
2. The Agreement is further amended by deleting Section 3 and substituting therefor
 - "3. (1) Subject to Section 19, Her Majesty agrees to make a contribution to the Recipient of an amount not to exceed FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00) ("the Contribution") for the carrying out of the Project.
 - (2) The Contribution shall be paid as follows:
 - (a) an initial advance
 - (i) in the amount of SIXTEEN THOUSAND EIGHTY-EIGHT (\$16,088.00) DOLLARS, equal to the estimated cash flow requirements of the Recipient for the first two (2) month term of the Agreement, and
 - (ii) payable within twenty (20) days after the effective date of this Agreement or the signing of the Agreement whichever is later.
 - (b) a second advance
 - (i) in the amount of TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$28,550.00), equal to the estimated cash flow requirements of the Recipient; and

- (ii) payable within twenty (20) days after the effective date of this Agreement or the signing of the Agreement whichever is later.
 - (c) subsequent advances
 - (i) paid monthly, upon receipt and verification by the Minister of a Monthly Financial Report submitted by the Recipient, and in accordance with budget items set out in Appendix "B-1", and
 - (ii) subject to adjustments, if any, based on the accounting for the previous payments.
 - (3) (a) The Recipient shall ensure that all costs invoiced are net of any Input Tax Credits or other forms of rebate of Goods and Services Tax (GST) to which the Recipient may be entitled.
 - (b) Invoices or progress claims submitted by the Recipient shall be net of any Input Tax Credits or other forms of rebate of GST to which the Recipient may be entitled."
3. Section 4 of the Agreement is deleted and the following is substituted therefor
- "4. The Recipient shall use the Contribution for the carrying out of the Project in accordance with the budget set out in Appendix "B-1"."
4. Section 25 of the Agreement is deleted and the following is substituted therefor
- "25. This Agreement consists of:
- (1) the preamble;
 - (2) the provisions of the Agreement;
 - (3) the document attached hereto, marked Appendix "A-1" and entitled "Objectives and Activities";
 - (4) the document attached hereto, marked Appendix "B-1" and entitled "Budget"; and
 - (5) the document attached hereto, marked Annex "1-1" and entitled "Monthly Financial Report".
5. The Agreement is further amended by deleting Appendix "A" and substituting therefor the attached Appendix "A-1".
6. The Agreement is further amended by deleting Appendix "B" and substituting therefor the attached Appendix "B-1".

- 7. The Agreement is further amended by deleting Annex "1" and substituting therefor the attached Annex "1-1".
- 8. All other terms and conditions shall remain the same.

THIS AMENDING BRIGHTER FUTURES CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT has been executed on behalf of the Recipient and on behalf of Her Majesty by their duly authorized officers as of this 23rd day of February, 1994, and is deemed to be in force as of and from that date.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES
INNU NATION HEALTH COMMISSION
BRIGHTER FUTURES MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM

1. (1) OBJECTIVES

- (a) To develop a fundamental examination of mental health.
- (b) To identify problems in the community, and to identify needs based on findings.
- (c) To visualize a healthy future.
- (d) These results will form part of the comprehensive community planning exercise required by the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada as part of the relocation.

(2) ACTIVITIES

- (a) Our strategy for creating a brighter future will begin by visualizing a healthy future. This common vision will then become a framework into which we direct our resources and planning.
- (b) To make community aware of where the present community dysfunction exists.
- (c) To make available to the Innu people, their History.
- (d) To identify the old ways of living that there were Innu ways of living based on beliefs and values that were the basis of healthy culture.
- (e) To hold a series of workshops on different stages of our Vision Quest.
- (f) To develop a steering committee that will oversee the work of the project as well as the production of a final report.

2. SUICIDE PREVENTION/INTERVENTION COORDINATOR¹

(1) OBJECTIVES

- (a) To provide an experience and skilled human services to front line staff when dealing with the many demanding and frustrating crisis and suicide intervention work. The Suicide Prevention coordinator will be responsible to Innu through the coordinator for healing services in Utshimassit.
