For your information: This is the reply that Sean Dutton, DM of Labrador and Aboriginal Affairs, Government of Newfoundland and Labrador, sent to INAC's Ian Gray regarding the social service costs (\$1.7) included in their outstanding \$3M claim. It appears that they are not prepared to negotiate this balance as part of the leave on the table money and that they intend to press Health Canada for the full \$3M, since they have an agreement with us.

Thanks to Annette for finding a copy of the agreement. The province actually located the correct amendment yesterday and forwarded a copy to us. In a letter sent to the A/ADM of Health and Community Services, we again indicated that Health Canada will pay 90% of the \$1.3, as these are health related costs, but do not have the mandate to pay for the rest.

Bernard: Debra would like to know, based on your review of the contribution agreement, your thoughts regarding Newfoundland's position to press for the remaining \$1.7M from us.
