Subject: Labrador

Here's the latest piece of good news! I was informed in the last few minutes that 3 children from Labrador have just begun the solvent treatment program in Sagkeem and a fourth is on the way. There is, unfortunately, nothing that could have been done about it because Sagkeem has funding in its contribution agreement to transport its clients to the centre and so no permission from the clients' home region has to be granted. The saving grace here is that these children apparently have been on the waiting list for these beds for months; their acceptance into the facility, therefore, had nothing directly to do with our current crisis in Labrador.
